Visual appearance is getting more and more into the center of awareness in scientific environments. Excelellent content needs superior packaging for equivalent and homologous presentations. The most important parts of an amazing and visionary design are easily recognizable and highly sophisticated emblems. Usage and reproduction quality should not suffer when targeting print media. To support the cumbersome and error prone task of corporate identity maintainance in $\[MText{EX}\]$, this package contains somewhat ambitious macros for the **RNNTH**, a research university of technology located in Aachen, North Rhine-Westphalia, Germany.

There are three predefined macros:



The default call of \RWTH*{} without any optional parameters renders **RWTH**, **RWTHAACHEN** and **RWTH** inline. Baseline and extent should somehow match the actual font height. Invocation should work in any place where regular text is accepted. In math mode the \text macro is required $sin(x^{\text{WWH}})$.

Optional parameters allow quite flexible customisations:

In short: color defines the logo color, accolor defines the color of 'AACHEN' and 'UNIVERSITY'. bgcolor defines the background color, margin and padding defines margin and padding. rotate does ..., you guess it. Its a *pgf* drawing inside an *adjustbox* (for more option documentation see there).
